

We can do that. But...

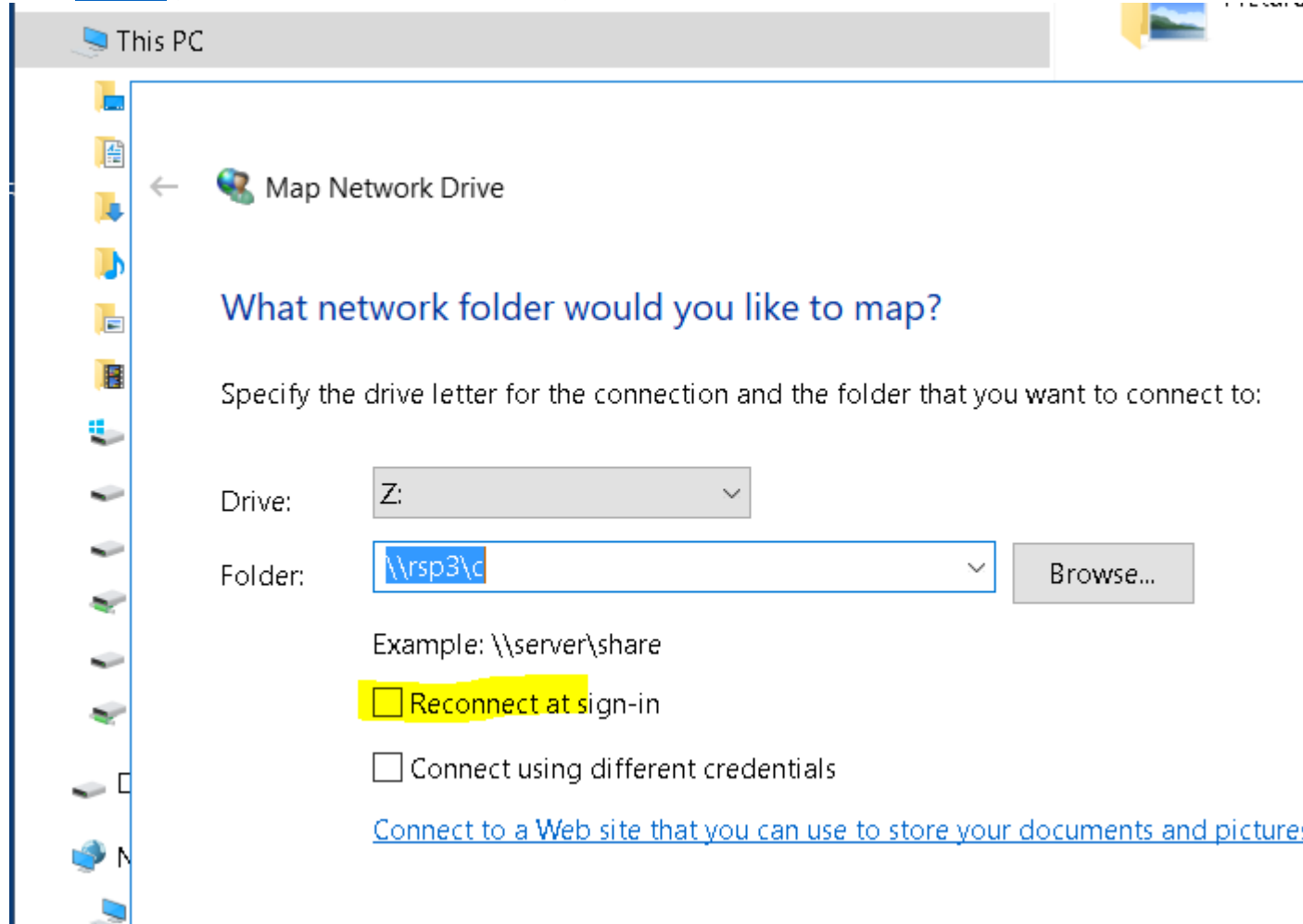
If you familiar with mapped drives then it is not that hard.

No need to start DDC

Just power the DPU

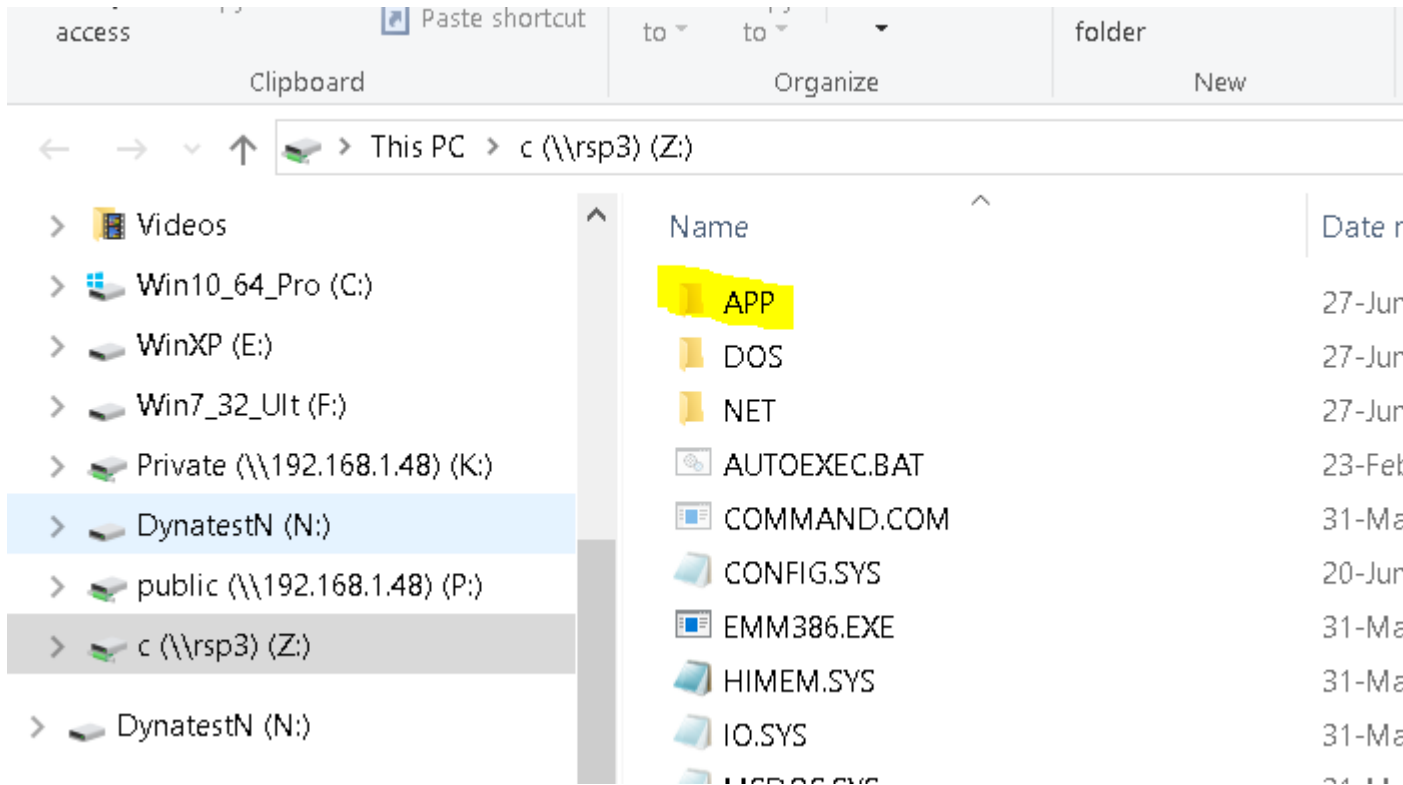
In Windows Explorer, right click "This PC" and chose "Map network drive..."

Enter `\\rsp3\c` (this is the C: drive on the flash disk) – click "Finish"



You should now see the contents of the DPU Flash disk.

Copy the new RSP3MAIN.EXE into the APP folder (overwrite the old one).



After this you should “Disconnect” the Z: drive and reboot the DPU.
